- Dividers for each binder
- 1 Spiral bound notebooks (Health)
- Loose-leaf filler paper for binders
- Loose-leaf graph paper
- Highlighters (different colors)
- Colored pencils, pencils, and pens
- Mini-stapler and staples
- Metric ruler
- Protractor (for Geometry students)
- TI-84 Plus Calculator



LOCKER SUPPLIES

- Locker shelf and organizers
- Combination lock
- Tissues
- Hand sanitizer
- Reusable water bottle
- Extra face mask (in a plastic zip lock bag)
- Anti-bacterial wipes (optional)
- Kippot (5-10 extra)
- Tallit and Tefillin (optional, but suggested)
- Hanging locker pouch for extra pens, pencils
- Dry erase board, markers, magnets (optional)

- 3-hole punch for a 3-ring binder

- Sturdy supportive backpack
- Folder or accordion folder for homework
- Pencil case that fits in a binder
- USB flash drive (minimum 8 GB)

SCIENCE
