"If I am not for myself, who will be for me? If I am only for myself, what am I? If not now, when?" (Rabbi Hillel, *Pirkei Avot*). These questions are not independent from one another; rather, they are inseparable. We must be constantly mindful in these complicated times that we are equally responsible for protecting both our own and others' health and safety. Each and every one of us in the community must sign this Kehillah/Community Commitment to affirm that our mutual sense of responsibility is our highest priority. Our families and staff agree to be guided by our four Derech Eretz values: Honor, Moral Courage, Kindness and Community and to comply with each of the following terms:

- Get a flu shot by November 15th, 2020.
- Wear a mask at all times while on campus and adhere to six-foot distancing. There will be zero tolerance for noncompliance.
- Stay home when not feeling well or when exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms.
- Complete the Ruvna checklist every morning before school in order to be on campus.
- Contact the school immediately should a member of the family contract COVID-19 or be exposed to someone with COVID-19 or if you have been told by the health department to self-quarantine.
- Follow federal, state, local and institutional guidelines to help reduce the transmission of COVID-19.
- Alert the school if you or a family member has traveled outside the country or state in the past month or during the school year (and follow CDC and statewide guidelines regarding quarantine).
- Encourage family members and each other to follow our new norms, protocols and expectations.
- Follow all school signage and bathroom protocols while on campus.
- Refrain from hosting parties, social gatherings, attending events off campus that may cause risk to the greater community.
- Understand and accept that socialization will look different at school.
- Understand that Barrack will be closed to all visitors, including parents.
- Uphold communal standards and expectations for health and safety both in and out of school.
- Report to the school any exposure or contact with individuals with COVID-19.

We have a zero tolerance policy in effect. Failure to comply with these terms will result in dismissal from campus and further disciplinary actions.
