DAILY SCHOOL SUPPLIES

- 3-7 3-ring binders: 1 for each subject (Eng, Hist, Sci, Math, Heb, JS, *Tanakh*)
or at least 3 binders (E/H, S/M and Heb/JS/T) **or** College lined notebooks
- Dividers for each binder
- Loose-leaf filler paper for binders
- Loose-leaf Graph paper
- Highlighters (different colors)
- Colored pencils, pencils and pens
- Mini-stapler and staples
- Small metric ruler
- Protractor (for Geometry students)
- TI-84 Plus Calculator



LOCKER SUPPLIES

- Locker shelf
- Combination lock
- Tissues
- Hand sanitizer
- Reusable water bottle
- Kippot (5-10 extra)
- Tallit and Tefillin (optional, but suggested)
- Hanging locker pouch for extra pens, pencils
- Dry erase board, markers, magnets (optional)
