



Dear Parents:

State law (Act 195) authorizes the loan of textbooks by the Secretary of Education to children enrolled in non-public schools. Act 90 authorizes the loan of instructional materials. Barrack is now in the process of requesting the specific textbooks and materials to be loaned to your children. The law requires, however, that a parent of each child attending a non-public school individually request a loan of the textbooks. We are, therefore, asking you to sign the following statement form and return it to school immediately.

Please note that individual, numbered copies of state-owned books are issued to each student; students are responsible for loaned books, and for the return in good condition of the specific books issued to them.
